Gujarat (IN Ahmedabad- IN Dwarka - IN Somnath -IN Sasan Gir- IN Diu - 2N Ahmedabad)

Day 1: Arrival at Ahmedabad

On your arrival in Ahmedabad, the vibrant capital city of Gujarat, you will check in to your hotel and freshen up. Later in the day, you can explore some of the city's most iconic attractions. Begin with a visit to the Sabarmati Ashram, the residence of Mahatma Gandhi, where history and peace coexist. Afterwards, head to the Adalaj Stepwell, a marvel of Indo-Islamic architecture that leaves every visitor mesmerized. By evening, you can enjoy a visit to the grand Akshardham Temple in Gandhinagar, where the intricate carvings and optional laser show make the experience magical. For those who enjoy shopping, the Law Garden Night Market is perfect to explore local handicrafts. Overnight stay in Ahmedabad.



 ARRIVAL

Day 2: Ahmedabad to Bhuj



After breakfast, begin your long but scenic drive to Bhuj, the cultural heart of Kutch. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and relax for a while. Later in the afternoon, explore Bhuj's heritage with visits to the Swaminarayan Temple, famous for its white marble beauty, followed by Aina Mahal and Prag Mahal, two palaces that showcase the region's glorious past. A stroll through the Kutch Museum, the oldest in Gujarat, gives a deeper insight into local traditions and history. Return to the hotel for overnight stay in Bhuj.

Day 3: Bhuj – Excursion to the Rann of Kutch

This day is dedicated to exploring the enchanting Rann of Kutch. After an early breakfast, drive to the Great Rann, stopping at Kala Dungar, the highest point in Kutch, which offers panoramic views of the vast salt desert. Along the way, visit traditional Kutchi villages like Hodka and Nirona, where you can witness the famous embroidery, handicrafts, and art forms of the region. By evening, reach Dhordo, the gateway to the White Desert, and enjoy the breathtaking view of the sunset as the white sands change hues under the twilight. After soaking in the surreal beauty, return to Bhuj for overnight stay.

- **Day 4: Bhuj to Jamnagar**



After breakfast, check out and drive towards Jamnagar. On arrival, check in at the hotel and take some rest. Later in the evening, you can visit the serene Lakhota Lake with its palace in the middle, which also houses a small museum. Another highlight of the town is the Bala Hanuman Temple, world-renowned for its uninterrupted chanting of “Ram Dhun,” which has been recorded in the Guinness Book of World Records. Enjoy a peaceful evening before retiring for the night in Jamnagar.

- **Day 5: Jamnagar to Dwarka**

After a leisurely breakfast, proceed to the holy city of Dwarka, one of the four revered Char Dham pilgrimage sites. Once you check in at the hotel, set out for your temple visits. Begin with the Dwarkadhish Temple, dedicated to Lord Krishna, where the evening aarti is truly a divine experience. You can also visit the Rukmini Temple, dedicated to Krishna’s consort, and the famous Nageshwar Jyotirlinga, one of the twelve sacred Jyotirlingas of Lord Shiva. If time permits, take a short boat ride to visit Bet Dwarka, believed to be Lord Krishna’s ancient residence. Overnight stay in Dwarka.

- **Day 6: Dwarka to Somnath via Porbandar**



After breakfast, depart for Somnath. On the way, halt at Porbandar, the birthplace of Mahatma Gandhi, and visit Kirti Mandir, which houses a small museum about his life. Continue your drive to Somnath and check in to your hotel on arrival. In the evening, visit the famous Somnath Temple, one of the twelve Jyotirlingas, located right by the Arabian Sea. Witness the evening aarti and, if you wish, stay back for the light and sound show that narrates the temple’s glorious history. Overnight stay in Somnath.

- **Day 7: Somnath to Diu**

After breakfast, proceed towards Diu, a serene coastal town with a blend of Portuguese charm and natural beauty. Once you check in at your hotel, explore the historic Diu Fort, standing strong by the sea, and St. Paul’s Church, a stunning example of baroque architecture. Later, relax at Nagoa Beach, where you may also try optional water sports or simply unwind by the waves. Diu offers a unique blend of history, culture, and relaxation. Overnight stay in Diu.

• **Day 8: Diu to Sasan Gir**

This morning, drive to Sasan Gir, home to the majestic Asiatic Lions. After checking in at your resort, you can head out for a thrilling jungle safari in Gir National Park (advance booking is required). The park is not only famous for lions but also hosts leopards, antelopes, and a wide variety of bird species. The evening is free to relax at your resort amidst nature. Overnight stay in Sasan Gir.

• **Day 9: Departure from Sasan Gir**

After breakfast, bid farewell to Sasan Gir. Depending on your travel plans, you can either drive back to Ahmedabad (about 7 hours) or to Rajkot (about 3 hours) for your onward journey. Your Gujarat trip concludes with wonderful memories of cultural heritage, temples, wildlife, and beaches.
