

North East (IN Guwahati - 2N Shillong - IN Cheerapunjee)

Day 1: Arrival at Guwahati – Local Sightseeing

On arrival at Guwahati Airport / Railway Station, you will be greeted and transferred to your hotel. After check-in, begin local sightseeing with a visit to the famous Kamakhya Temple, one of the most important Shakti Peethas. Later, enjoy a peaceful boat ride to Umananda Temple (Peacock Island on the Brahmaputra River). In the evening, take a sunset river cruise on the Brahmaputra, enjoying the view of the city lights along the riverbanks.

Overnight stay at Guwahati.





## Day 2: Guwahati – Shillong (100 km / 3 hrs)



After breakfast, drive towards Shillong, popularly known as the "Scotland of the East". Enroute, stop at Umiam Lake (Barapani), a serene reservoir surrounded by pine-clad hills – perfect for photography. Upon arrival in Shillong, check into your hotel and relax. In the afternoon, explore Ward's Lake, Shillong Peak (the highest point of Shillong with panoramic views), and Elephant Falls, cascading down in three layers amidst lush greenery. Overnight stay at Shillong.

# Day 3: Excursion to Mawlynnong & Dawki – Back to Shillong

After breakfast, proceed for a full-day excursion to Mawlynnong, Asia's cleanest village. Walk through bamboo pathways, enjoy village life, and see the Living Root Bridge. Later, continue to Dawki, on the India-Bangladesh border, famous for the crystal-clear waters of the Umngot River where you can enjoy a boat ride. Return to Shillong by evening and stroll around Police Bazaar for shopping. Overnight stay at Shillong.







Day 4: Shillong – Cherrapunjee (60 km / 2 hrs)

After breakfast, drive to Cherrapunjee, renowned as one of the wettest places on Earth. Enroute, stop at breathtaking viewpoints like Elephant Falls (if missed earlier). In Cherrapunjee, visit Nohkalikai Falls (the tallest plunge waterfall in India), Seven Sisters Falls, Mawsmai Cave (limestone cave with stalactites & stalagmites), and Eco Park. Evening free to enjoy the misty surroundings. Overnight stay at Cherrapunjee.

Day 5: Cherrapunjee – Guwahati Departure

After breakfast, drive back to Guwahati (approx. 4–5 hrs). Depending on flight/train timing, visit Assam State Museum or local markets for souvenirs. Transfer to Airport/Railway Station for onward journey with wonderful memories.
