

Day 1: Arrival at Coorg - Coffee Land of India

Arrive at Bangalore/Mysore and drive towards Coorg (approx. 5-6 hrs from Bangalore / 3 hrs from Mysore). On arrival, check in at your hotel/resort surrounded by lush greenery. In the evening, visit Abbey Falls, gushing amidst coffee plantations, and later head to Raja's Seat, a popular sunset viewpoint offering mesmerizing valley views. End the day strolling through Madikeri town, shopping for coffee, spices, and homemade chocolates.

Overnight stay in Coorg.



# Day 2: Coorg Sightseeing - Elephants, Monastery & Plantations



After breakfast, head to Dubare Elephant Camp, where you can watch elephants being bathed, fed, and trained. Later, proceed to Namdroling Monastery (Golden Temple) at Bylakuppe, one of the largest Tibetan settlements in South India, with stunning golden statues and vibrant prayer halls. In the afternoon, enjoy a visit to Cauvery Nisargadhama, a river island with bamboo groves and deer park, and later a plantation walk to experience the aroma of fresh Coorg coffee. Evening free to relax at your resort. Overnight stay in Coorg.

# Day 3: Coorg to Ooty - Drive to the Nilgiris (Approx. 6-7 hrs)

After breakfast, check out and drive towards Ooty, the Queen of Hill Stations, passing through forest reserves and winding ghat roads. On arrival, check in at your hotel. In the evening, enjoy boating at the picturesque Ooty Lake, visit the unique Thread Garden, and explore the local market for souvenirs and handmade chocolates.

Overnight stay in Ooty.







Day 4: Ooty & Coonoor Excursion - Peaks & Valleys

After breakfast, enjoy a full day exploring Ooty & Coonoor. Visit the Government Botanical Garden and Rose Garden, followed by a scenic drive to Dodabetta Peak, the highest point in Nilgiris with stunning views. Later, drive or take an optional toy train ride to Coonoor. Visit Sims Park, Dolphin's Nose Viewpoint, and a Tea Factory & Museum, where you can enjoy tasting freshly brewed Nilgiri tea. Return to Ooty by evening. Overnight stay in Ooty.

## Day 5: Ooty to Mysore - Palaces & Gardens (Approx. 4.5 hrs / 125 km)

After breakfast, check out and drive towards Mysore. Enroute, enjoy scenic views of Bandipur & Mudumalai forests. On arrival in Mysore, check in at your hotel. Later, visit the grand Mysore Palace, an architectural gem reflecting royal grandeur, and Chamundi Hill with its towering Nandi statue. In the evening, witness the musical fountain show at Brindavan Gardens. Overnight stay in Mysore.

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and drive towards Bangalore / Mysore Railway Station / Airport for your onward journey with sweet memories of Coorg's coffee, Ooty's tea gardens, and Mysore's royal palaces.
