

Day 1: Arrival at Bangalore – Garden City Exploration

Arrive at Bangalore Airport / Railway Station and transfer to your hotel. After check-in, proceed for sightseeing of the vibrant Garden City of India. Visit the iconic Lalbagh Botanical Garden, spread across 240 acres with rare plant species, followed by the majestic Bangalore Palace, inspired by Tudor-style architecture. Later, see the grand Vidhana Soudha, seat of the state legislature (outside view), and spend the evening at the bustling MG Road / Brigade Road for shopping and cafes.

Overnight stay in Bangalore.



Day 2: Bangalore to Mysore – Palaces & Illumination (Approx. 3.5 hrs / 150 km)



After breakfast, drive to Mysore, the City of Palaces. Enroute, stop at Srirangapatna, the historic capital of Tipu Sultan, to visit Sri Ranganathaswamy Temple, Daria Daulat Bagh, and Gumbaz Mausoleum. Continue to Mysore and check in at your hotel. In the afternoon, visit the magnificent Mysore Palace, famous for its Indo-Saracenic architecture and royal history. Later, explore Chamundi Hill with its towering Nandi statue and Brindavan Gardens, which come alive in the evening with colorful musical fountains.

Overnight stay in Mysore.

BREAKFAST

Day 3: Mysore to Ooty – Journey to the Nilgiris (Approx. 4.5 hrs / 125 km)

After breakfast, check out and drive towards Ooty, passing through Bandipur & Mudumalai forest reserves (chance to spot deer, elephants, or peacocks enroute). Arrive in Ooty, the Queen of Hill Stations, and check in at your hotel. In the evening, enjoy boating at the picturesque Ooty Lake, stroll through the Thread Garden, and shop for handmade chocolates in the local market.

Overnight stay in Ooty.



Day 4: Ooty & Coonoor Sightseeing – Tea Gardens & Valley Views

After breakfast, set out to explore Ooty and Coonoor. Visit the Government Botanical Gardens and the Rose Garden, housing thousands of floral varieties. Drive up to Dodabetta Peak, the highest point in the Nilgiris, offering panoramic views of the mountains. Later, proceed to Coonoor and visit Sims Park, Dolphin's Nose Viewpoint, and a Tea Factory & Museum, where you can enjoy freshly brewed Nilgiri tea. Return to Ooty by evening and relax. Overnight stay in Ooty.





Day 5: Departure from Ooty

After breakfast, check out and proceed to Bangalore / Coimbatore / Mysore for your onward journey with unforgettable memories of palaces, gardens, and misty hill stations. Overnight stay in Ooty.
